A message from our Board Chair and Executive Director

This has been one of the most unique years for all of us. Kali's Wish started the year strong by engaging at trade shows, meeting new/key stakeholders, and running creative campaigns that proved to be successful.

However, unlike no other organization, the COVID-19 pandemic threw us a curve and forced us to think differently about our outreach work. No longer able to visit the parks and participate in tradeshows, we had to revisit our community impact and how to best honour our partnering sponsors that support this program.

Already offering services online, we now needed to extend our reach and build a greater sense of online community. We brought in social influencers, strengthened online brand partnerships and simply shared and pushed our message a lot more, to find those who needed help! We have learned that the isolation so many of us have felt during this past year was deeply felt by pet families experiencing pet cancer.

This year has taught us adaptability and the importance of being nimble.

In 2021, we will take what we have learned and use it to build new programs that align with this new virtual world. We hope to engage with people face-to-face again soon, but in the meantime we will rework our outreach to reflect the current environment.

Thank you to everyone who reached out to us and kept engaged with Kali's Wish; this includes our Board of Directors, who have helped steer Kali's Wish into new waters.

In December, we received very long exciting and long awaited news that Kali's Wish was approved by the Canada Revenue agency as an official tax exempt charity. This means Kali's Wish is now the only charity in Canada that supports a family through pet cancer. We can now also provide tax receipts to donors who wish to receive one.

We look to exciting new work in 2021 as a registered charity.

Kali's Wish Cancer Foundation is the first and only not-for-profit organization to solely support pet guardians and their families facing pet cancer.

Ask the Vet

Connect with a vet for advice and/or a second opinion. Guardians can write us through our website and ask a veterinarian any question about their pet's cancer journey for free.

Our vets volunteer their time to provide quality information in a timely manner.

Buddy Up!

A buddy, a friend. We have a network of Guardians impacted by pet cancer who now give their time to support others facing the disease.

Write us through our website and ask to connect with a guardian. We try our best to match the types of cancer and where you are in your journey, so you can have some comfort from a person who has faced a similar experience.

"I am pleased to make your acquaintance, but I am also devastated for you. There is no tougher thing than going through cancer with a loved one. (Furry or otherwise). You have my most sincere sympathy ... in that you need to deal with this at all... but as you are making your choice to go forward I would love to be a sounding board for you.

I did write the Kali's wish experts... but I wanted to talk to someone who had seen their dog before and after treatment and find out their point of view. I didn't know that option was available to me. I would love to be that option for you ...

For the time being ... I wonder if we could start out with emails ... and go from there. Please don't hesitate ... drop me a line.

Along with everything you are hearing from the oncologist, let's make this an informative experience."

March 2020: • The University of Calgary Veterinary Trade Show

Engaging with the next generation of veterinarians, Kali's Wish was invited to join this trade show and share our positive of message on the ways we help support pet families through pet cancer.
