# A MESSAGE FROM THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR & BOARD CHAIR



The pet families that have connected for support shared that our programs are working! We received a lot of feedback that the services we offer are a huge support as they work through cancer with their beloved animal. We took this information and ran with it, looking for every opportunity we could to share our programs with more families.

The request for our Kali Kares care packages alone grew by more than 800% since 2020. When pet Guardians connected with us for a care package, we called every one of them and talked to them about what they were facing and offered additional help!

It didn't end there. Now that we were connecting with more Guardians, we realized our help extended past that initial call. We started following up. At three months from first connecting, we would send a note to check in. The response was eye opening. Within three months, many Guardians had moved onto another phase of their pet cancer journey. For some, it was remission or a new treatment, but for many, sadly it was the loss of their pet.

Knowing this, we adapted and by the end of this year we started a loss package that contains a healing candle, information on grief and getting through loss, and the offer for more help and connection to people who have been through it!


The more we learn from our Guardians, the more we can build the right programs to help them get through cancer and end-of-life of their pet.

This upcoming year will be filled with new knowledge. We received a grant from the Government of Alberta to support vulnerable populations through cancer and palliative care with their pets. Recognizing a person's mental health can drastically decrease after the loss of a beloved animal, we will be working with organizations in the Alberta non-profit sector to learn how we can better support vulnerable populations that are facing end-of-life with their companion animal.

It will be another exciting year where we trek across unchartered territory! As the only charity to offer this kind of support, we look forward to sharing what we learn!

## 2022 CAMPAIGN KONG

## One campaign to highlight was this year's "KONG Toys for Dogs with Cancer."

The fundraising took place in October by participating Pet Planet stores. They asked their customers for donations to a KONG toy drive. Once \$8 was reached, which is half the retail price of a toy, KONG donated a toy.

This year, the Pet Planet stores went above and beyond and fundraised just over \$10,000 for Kali's Wish and KONG donated 1371 toys!

Kali's Wish received the toys in December, and with support from the Pet Planet stores we distributed them to organizations and veterinary clinics and pet hospitals across Canada. It was our largest toy fundraising campaign and distribution of toys we have ever had! This campaign continues to grow and gain momentum, but it would not exist without our partners at Pet Planet and KONG. We thank you!

A new toy does make a difference to a sick animal, and it takes the stress off the whole family for a small moment while the animal enjoys a new toy!




